The meeting was called to order by President Pete Olivere at 7:30pm.
About 25 people were present.

Our guest speaker was Vic Atwall of Dominion Virginia Power. Mr. Atwall reviewed the 6 major storms for May & June 2008 and a map of Glen Carlyn's power grid. Our power is derived from: ~30% nuclear, ~30% coal, ~10% gas, ~10% hydroelectric, and ~10% oil. The freeze on base rates for power will end in 2009; expect a raise in the rates.

- Treasurer's Report by Tim Aiken: A detailed analysis of 2008 budget and proposed 2009 budget was presented and approved (see enclosure). The undercharging for printing of the VV will not be billed to GC.
