## Minutes of the February 6, 2011, 7:30 Meeting

1. **Adoption of Agenda:** The agenda was adopted.
  
2. The President of the GCA opened the meeting by asking that all attendees introduce themselves
  
3. Program: - 7:35 - 8:10 - John Chadwick, Director, Design and Construction for the Arlington Public Schools (APS) Capacity Planning Process and possible construction at Carlin Spring or Kenmore. Currently there are 20821 students enrolled in the Arlington Public Schools. There are an additional 1044 students in the pre K programs. There are 1973 Kindergarten students which is an increase of 18% in 5 years. All schools except Hoffman Boston are at or exceeding capacity. By 2017 demographers expect 27,000 students which would equal the highest ever and by 2020 there will be 31,000 students if present rates continue. Currently there are 83 mobile classrooms and 28 more will be added in summer 2012. The old building program concentrated on renovation while these new program is renovation and increasing capacity. Decision Lens INC is assisting the school board in reviewing 18 sites for building/renovation. Some of the building could be done on land owned by the county. On 15 Feb there will be a community update. In May the Superintendent will present the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) recommendations to the School Board and there will be public hearing. This will be the basis of the November Bond referendum. In addition there will be several more meetings. All meetings are open to the public.
