Minutes of the April 2, 2012, 7:30 PM Meeting

1. **The Agenda** was adopted.

2. The President of the GCA opened the meeting by asking that all attendees identify themselves.

Program: Jeremy Watson, an engineer with Arlington's division of Transportation discussed the draft design for the Route 50 (Arlington Blvd)/Manchester St. intersection. He stated that funding has been approved and that the intersection upgrade will be executed. He took copious notes as members of the GCA discussed their current problems with the intersection. They also offered recommendations as to how the design could be improved. Mr. Watson said he would come back and present the final engineering design. He is available to any community member who wishes to provide input.

Pete Olivere, the GCA President discussed the status of the Arlington Public Schools (APS) elementary schools building project. There is a need for additional elementary level classrooms and few open spaces within the county for those proposed buildings. The GCA has expressed its concern that APS wishes to build another school between Carlin Springs and Kenmore schools. The President asked for a received the nod to continue to press GCA's concerns with the school board.
